Arlington Heights Civic Association - April 10, 2018 Meeting Minutes

The April 10, 2018 meeting of the Arlington Heights Civic Association was called to order by President Kristi Sawert at 7:05. Ms. Sawert determined a quorum was present. Scott Winn, Treasurer, reported that the civic association has 32 dues paying members and \$1,343.72 in our account.

Kristi Sawert provided an update on the Career Center Working Group. She detailed the topics of their bi-weekly meetings, including the presentation about the Montessori program and Columbia Pike Library. There are three more meetings scheduled. Ms. Sawert updated attendees on the student population estimates, with 3500 students anticipated in 2022.

Ms. Sawert requested a vote on the resolution available on the AHCA website <a href="http://www.ahca.info/">http://www.ahca.info/</a>. There was discussion about the requirements for notice as specified in the bylaws. A vote was taken and the resolution was passed. Ms. Sawert asked us to attend the County Board-School Board joint work session about the future of the Career Center site: TUESDAY, APRIL 17, from 6:30 to 8:30 PM, 2100 CLARENDON BLVD. ROOM 307

Tim McIntosh, Neighborhood Conservation Program Manager, and Chris Balallo, Department of Environmental Services, provided an update on the Irving Street Trail Project, funded in 2011. The current path is discontinuous and has drainage issues. The project will fix the drainage problems, extend the path from S. Fillmore St. to TJ Park, expand the path to 10', separate it from the highway, and realign the S. Highland St./Arlington Blvd. intersection to improve safety. Parking in front of Etz Hayim will remain, but a planted buffer will separate it from the trail. Jill Yutan, landscape architect for the NC Program, stated that 22 invasive trees will be removed and replaced by 36 fast-growing native trees, including red cedars and holly.
